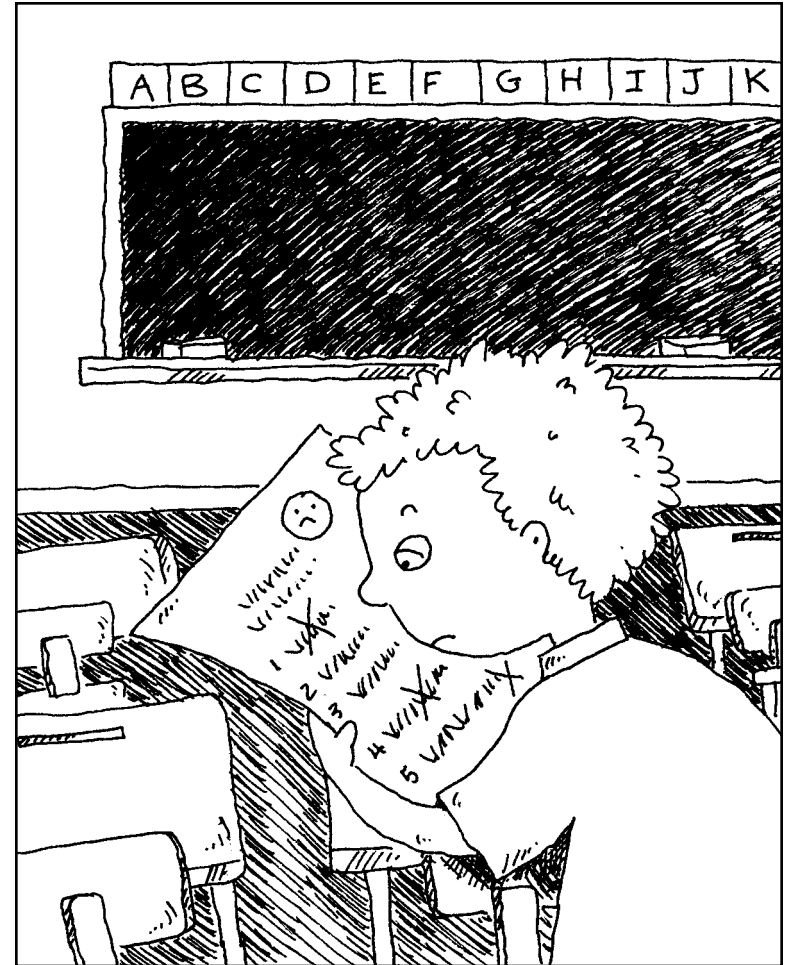
I woke up too late,
